Activity:	Learn to use iNaturalist in the field. Bring your phone, and, to save time, please pre-load the free iNaturalist app. Our leader, Vince Hale, will take you into the Preserve and provide tips on navigating this powerful app effectively.
	From iNaturalist: Every observation can contribute to biodiversity science, from the rarest butterfly to the most common backyard weed. We share your findings with scientific data repositories, such as the Global Biodiversity Information Facility, to help scientists locate and utilize your data. All you have to do is observe.
	According to Vince, iNaturalist Ambassadors are iNaturalist members who are excited to share their love of nature and help others discover iNaturalist. We hope to inspire our local community to explore, document, and protect biodiversity by hosting events, giving talks, and connecting people to iNaturalist in other creative ways. Vince is also an avid nature photographer.
